Wild Challengers

Year 1 has been on a real biodiversity drive. They have been taking part in the RSPB Wild Challenge, exploring the biodiversity of the school and discovering flora and fauna within our school grounds, looking for tracks and signs of wildlife; finding nuts and seeds; using their senses to find a rainbow of colours outside; and searching for fantastic fungi.

They are helping nature too, they completed a small bug hotel to add to the growing bug villages installed outside our school.

Their biggest achievement has been the planting of a new copse in the school grounds to establish a new wildlife corridor and an oasis for birds, containing silver birch, rowan and wild cherry.
