A note from the Headteacher

The festive season is almost upon us and we will be kicking off our celebrations with our annual Christmas Tree Assembly, led by Year 6 on Thursday 1 December at 9:00am. Each of our pupils has made a Christmas decoration to dress the tree and you are more than welcome to join us for the occasion if you wish.

Nursery, Reception and Key Stage 1 children will also be putting on a Christmas Production, for which tickets will be available from Monday of next week. The performances will take place on Tuesday 13 December at 2:15pm and Wednesday 14 December at 9:30am. Tickets will be sold on a first come first served basis and cost £2.50 for each person aged 3 years and upwards.

In addition, a special School Christmas Concert will take place on the last day of term Friday 16 December in the school hall, with performances by all children from Nursery to Year 6. Due to limited capacity, and to cover the cost of refreshments, tickets will be sold for £2.50 each and be limited initially to two per family. To purchase tickets for any of above performances, complete the tear off slip from the letters sent home and return it to your child's class teacher in an envelope marked 'Production Tickets' or 'School Christmas Concert' with your child's name and class plus a clear indication of which performance you wish to attend.
