As you will be aware from reports in the media, teachers belonging to the National Education Union have voted to participate in a strike over pay on Wednesday 1 February. It is my intention to reduce impact on our children and families and therefore I will take all reasonable steps to keep school open for all pupils. I am liaising with the local authority and undertaking a risk assessment to gauge our ability to open all year groups safely and I will share my findings with you, at the earliest possible opportunity next week. Because of the nature of strike action, I may need to communicate with you on the morning of Wednesday 1 February at the latest so please continue to check ParentMail regularly. Further strike action has been planned on the following dates Tuesday 28 February, Wednesday 15 March and Thursday 16 March and information regarding these dates will be sent out nearer the time.
