## A note from the Headteacher

In the midst of today's adverse weather and our resulting school closure, it is worthwhile reiterating our adverse weather procedures for any parents who may have missed our notifications. All reasonable efforts are made to ensure that the school remains open during bad weather. Any decision to close school has to be made early and conditions can change relatively quickly. The Headteacher will make the final decision based on local weather conditions, staff availability and a risk assessment of the premises and quality of access. Ultimately, the main factors behind any decision are whether there are enough staff in school to keep the children safe and whether children can access the school safely. The first notice of any school closure will appear on the school website as a tweet by @cromptonpri. This will be followed by a ParentMail message.
