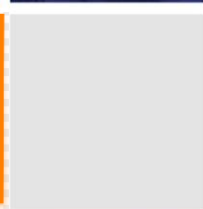

Eco School Committee Meeting

Our Eco Committee met this week to discuss progress and actions. We have decided to hold an Eco Day towards the end of this half term on Friday 19 May. Also, Years 1 – 6 have been given litter pickers to use regularly at break times so that the whole school can become involved with keeping the school litter free. The children will be counting the batteries we collected for the Big Battery Hunt. We will also be collecting curriculum links ahead of our Eco Schools inspection which is due in the Summer. We have already identified some links, such as Year 1's litter poster campaign; Year 3 upcycled planting for Science; Year 5's RSPB Challenge; the wormery in Early Years; and the Upper KS2 Big Schools Birdwatch...speaking of which, look out for the Mistle Thrush nesting on a lamppost in our school carpark.
