Football Freestyle Fantastic Fun

Football freestyler Ash visited on Monday to share his incredible tricks and skills with a football. The day started with a very popular assembly with Ash demonstrating his creative ball skills to music, using a range of props.

Ash broke his first world record certificate in 2010 and went on to break 25 more in subsequent years. He explained to children the importance or perseverance and resilience in achieving goals. "I've failed lots of tricks and I've failed lots of world records," he said, "but I've always gone back and worked twice as hard."

Ash donated a 2023 Guinness Book of World Records and challenged the children to search for his record in the books and find something that inspires them.
